He needs forgiving a lacklustre run behind stablemate Il Etait Temps when last seen, but **FACILE VEGA** has always been highly thought of and with the recent rain in his favour he may prove too strong for the Royal Bond winner Marine Nationale where it matters. The unbeaten Chasing Fire is respected, but the Tolworth winner Tahmuras looks the pick of the British team.

El Fabiolo only has a neck to find with **JONBON** on their Aintree hurdles run last season, and is very much respected after a commanding Irish Arkle win last time, but Nicky Henderson's young star looks the one to beat. He fared much the best of those who served it up to Constitution Hill in the Supreme last year and should relish this test. Front-runner Dysart Dynamo is respected.

CORACH RAMBLER rattled home to win this from 6 lb lower a year ago and, after catching the eye at Newbury last time, is fancied to go in again. Fastorslow took a step forward when upped in trip at this meeting last year, and more of the same is likely, while Leopardstown winner The Goffer is also feared. The in-form duo of Into Overdrive and Monbeg Genius also make the shortlist.

CONSTITUTION HILL has had the experts waxing lyrical since destroying his rivals in last year's Supreme, and though this is his toughest test yet, he is taken to extend his unbeaten run. The Willie Mullins-trained pair of State Man and Vauban, who were also winners at this meeting 12 months ago, are both good enough to win a Champion Hurdle. I Like To Move It will need to improve again.

Though beaten in two starts this season, **HONEYSUCKLE**'s form still looks rock solid and she knows her job around here, having won this race in 2021 and then the Champion Hurdle (Epatante second) last season. Should she fail to fire, then the race looks very open, with Shewearsitwell, Queens Brook and Brandy Love all joining Love Envoi and Echoes In Rain on a lengthy shortlist.

Irish runners have won each of the last five renewals, and they're taken to do so once more. Tekao's handicap mark looks a workable one, a comment that also applies to stablemate Risk Belle, but a chance is taken on the fellow JP McManus-owned **SUNDIAL** who caught the eye in his early qualifying runs. Sir Allen and Byker are respected, while French recruit Bad is a fascinating contender on his British debut.

Gaillard Du Mesnil has obvious form claims on his 3m victory in December, but, much like Chemical Energy, he hasn't always convinced with his jumping. Mahler Mission has been more consistent on that front of late, but it might be worth chancing **MINELLA CROONER**. He wasn't at his best last time but this race has been the plan for some time and he looks sure to improve for the longer trip.

Stablemate Gaelic Warrior is a big player and ahead of Champ Kiely in the yard's pecking order although his tendency to jump to his right is a negative on this track. Good Land is solid but lacks a wow factor.

The Real Whacker jumps and stays but is short enough as is the talented but inexperienced Sir Gerhard. Last year's Stayers' Hurdle runner-up Thyme Hill is respected while connections dug deep to supplement Adamantly Chosen.

Beacon Edge is well handicapped on old form but **GOOD RISK AT ALL** will find this trip more suitable and is open to improvement. Langer Dan and Fil Dor are others to note.
