

GRADE 2 - \$1,000,000



SCENE SETTER: Keeneland's titan of 2-year-olds and turf sprints, trainer Wesley Ward, has a natural bond with this race. His GOLDEN PAL's Skidmore win at Saratoga may have been the division's best domestically so far this year; filly AMANZI YIMPILO already beat the boys at Santa Anita; and fellow filly ROYAL APPROVAL has turned it on since a trip to Royal Ascot. Ward's CAMPANELLE is unbeaten and a major threat here or in the Juvenile Fillies Turf. Meanwhile, SECOND OF JULY owes no one a penny after 68-1 and 15-1 victories to open his career at Belmont.

Europeans are 12: 0-0-1 in the first 2 editions of the Juvenile Turf Sprint and comprised exactly half the entries both years.

Juvenile Turf Sprint winners Four Wheel Drive and Bulletin exited preps in the Futurity at Belmont and Hollywood Beach at Gulfstream Park.

Not only has the Juvenile Turf Sprint been won wire-to-wire in both of its editions to date, but the runner-up has been essentially second the entire way each time.

Lightly raced undefeated horses won the first 2 editions of this race, posting just 1 and 2 prior starts.



SCENE SETTER: Ireland's BATTLEGROUND, son of BC Turf and Arc de Triomphe heroine Found, brings a wonderful legacy and record stateside. Canada's GRETZKY THE GREAT has skated to victory in his last 2 stakes, and is another BC legacy as a son Juvenile champ Nyquist. The Yanks' best prospect, MUTASAABEQ, shot from a cannon late to win Keeneland's Bourbon. Chad Brown aims for back-to-back Juvenile Turf wins, this time with PUBLIC SECTOR.

Public Sector, keeping good company with Editor at Large (Juv Fillies Turf), galloped in a long, easy fashion to the pole only grabbing the bridle right on top of it, working head-and-head over a turf course listed as firm, but appeared to have some give to it. Final time was typical, but Public Sector appeared not to be going as well as the filly, and she won the gallop-out. I'm worried he won't handle the softer turf at Keeneland.

Nine of its 13 winners have paid between \$11 and \$20, making the Juvenile Turf one of the most attractive betting races in the Breeders' Cup. Its extremes are 2-1 as shortest-priced winner and 12-1 as highest.


Europeans own a 9-4 edge over the North Americans in this division, including 7 of the last 9, though Structor represented the US in victory a year ago.

Five of the 13 Juvenile Turf winners exited preps at England's Newmarket Racecourse, 4 of them via the Dewhurst Stakes.

SCENE SETTER: PRINCESS NOOR has dominated California's premier divisional races by nearly 15 lengths for Bob Baffert. But the speed figure aficionados claim she's not that fast. Fillies based at blue-collar Thistledown (DAYOUTOFTHEOFFICE) and Parx (VEQUIST) have been much-the-best in New York's signature stakes. Kentucky's key springboards have produced unbeatens GIRL DADDY and SIMPLY RAVISHING; the latter could give trainer Kenny McPeek, twice runner-up in this race, his first Breeders' Cup victory after 31 attempts.

Belmont's Frizette Stakes has produced 12 Juvenile Fillies winners, most of any single prep in any Breeders' Cup division.

6 times the Juvenile Fillies winner has paid \$60 or more, the most prolific longshot race in the Breeders' Cup series. Only the Distaff (4) has had more than 3 such upsetters.

Only twice in 36 runnings has the Juvenile Fillies winner had 2 or fewer previous starts – Caledonia Road (2017) and Indian Blessing (2007).

SCENE SETTER: PLUM ALI has stung like a bee in 3 knockout victories and may be trainer Christophe Clement's best chance to snap his 0-38 Breeders' Cup record. AUNT PEARL led every step of her 2 starts, hinting at future stardom, and has won over this course and distance. CAMPANELLE has spanned the globe from Gulfstream to England to France and has yet to meet her match in 3 sprint attempts. MOTHER EARTH and MISS AMULET are Group 1-placed in England and well-seasoned.

Last year's winner Sharing led all contenders in 'Last Turn Time,' which was a top-5 factor to consider. She was second-best in 'Avg. Turf Earnings,' the third-highest rated factor.

Working with older G2 Lake Placid winner Speaktomeofsummer, she broke behind with plenty of pep in her step wearing her usual ear plugs, tracking behind a pedestrian pace over a softer-than-firm turf course. She cruised up to her workmate and stayed there, albeit perhaps losing focus and switching leads a couple of times. Top filly in terrific form.

EDITOR AT LARGE 10/25 Belmont 5 furlongs (T) 1:02.69 (11/12) Editor at Large, keeping good company with Public Sector (Juv Turf), appeared to handle the turf – which looked a little softer than firm – with aplomb. Always going easier than her workmate, she switched leads on cue (even though her rider apparently didn't notice...another good sign). Terrific work for a trainer who excels in this race with 5 wins; this filly is live especially with the expected 'give' in the ground. I think she will handle it and she's bred to love it. Dangerous!

MADONE 10/22 Santa Anita 5 furlongs 1:03.60 (28/29) Turf filly working on the dirt, so we really can't tell a whole lot. She broke off nicely under Jack Stack and found some Mandella company turning for home. After being asked a couple of times to switch leads (she didn't), she wasn't asked again. Hard to tell a lot here other than dirt is NOT her preferred surface. That being said, I prefer others and feel the give in the ground at Kee will be her undoing.

North American-based fillies have captured 10 of the 12 runnings of the Juvenile Fillies Turf, shutting the Europeans out since 2012-'13. Euros are 0-7 as favorites.

Belmont Park's Miss Grillo Stakes has produced the Juvenile Fillies Turf winner in 5 of its 12 editions, most recently Newspaperofrecord in 2018.

No California-based filly has finished in the JFT exacta. The best finish was Colonel Joan's third-place run in 2013.



SCENE SETTER: No one's come close to beating JACKIE'S WARRIOR or ESSENTIAL QUALITY so far. The 2-turn question for JACKIE'S WARRIOR will be front of mind for handicappers as he seeks his 5th straight win. ESSENTIAL QUALITY won over the track and distance when scoring the Breeders' Futurity, but has made only 2 starts. Meanwhile, SITTIN ON GO rocked the Iroquois at 24-1. Does he have another upset in him?

SITTIN ON GO 10/23 Churchill 5 furlongs 1:00.40 (11/44)

Coming into the race off a series of very healthy works, recorded every 7 days like clockwork. He switched leads very smoothly here and just needed a bit of coaxing to finish up the work as strongly as he started it and to keep working out at a similar tempo for the gallop-out. Considering this lightly raced 2-year-old was without company to keep up his enthusiasm, this was a productive work.

ROMBAUER 10/22 Santa Anita 5 furlongs 1:03.60 (28/29) Gives the impression he is mature for a 2-year-old and a very steady individual on the dirt. He rightfully outworked a 2-year-old maiden filly by the name of Polished Lady, while staying in the same tempo for the duration of the work. His gallop-out was equally as steady. He'll appreciate a fast pace up front and could grind out a placing.



Historic Preakness heroine SWISS SKYDIVER has not ducked a challenge in any corner of America this year and could be Horse of the Year with a Distaff victory. VALIANCE won the oft-important Spinster over the host-site track, while HOROLOGIST exits a career-best in the Beldame.
